The site is located at Timbercrest Campground with full RV hookup sites. You can make reservations by calling (330) 893-2720. Campers and RVs can be rented and delivered to the site at [rvshare.com](http://rvshare.com). We have negotiated special rates at Wallhouse Hotel, but priority will be given to those with special needs. Finally, it must be noted that the Feast falls during fall foliage in an area ranked number three by National Geographic for fall foliage beauty. Therefore, making reservations early is important.
